

# RLX Market Report

## CTLX Sheep and Lamb Sale – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2024

Total Yarding: 10917 (-86) | Sheep Yarding: 4239 (+1953) | Lamb Yarding: 6678 (-2039)

Numbers dropped by 2039 for a yarding of 6678 lambs. Quality was mixed with mainly new season trade weights penned along with good runs of heavyweights and limited supply of store lambs. Most of the regular buyers were present and the market sold cheaper.

Lightweight processing lambs to 18kg fell \$15 to \$20, with new season lambs selling from \$60 to \$130, and old lambs, \$70 to \$115/head. Trade weights 20kg to 24kg eased \$3 to \$5, new season lambs sold from \$163 to \$205, and old lambs, \$160 to \$204/head, most selling between 770c and 820c/kg cwt. Heavyweights over 24kg were also \$3 to \$5 cheaper, new season lambs sold from \$208 to \$240, and old lambs, \$200 to \$269/head, averaging between 800c and 840c/kg cwt. Heavy hoggets reached \$140/head.

Sheep numbers lifted to 4239 and quality improved. Merino ewes sold from \$53 to \$118, and crossbred ewes, \$50 to \$149/head. Merino wethers sold from \$49 to \$110/head. Most mutton sold \$10 better and ranged between 320c and 360c/kg cwt.
